We are currently looking for two motivated volunteers from Germany to take part in a European Voluntary Service in Rustavi, Georgia (30 min from capital city Tbilisi). The project's duration is 12 months and starts on 1st of September 2018. The project is financed by the Erasmus+ programme of the European Commission.

The European Voluntary Service "Discover the Caucasus 4" involves two volunteers from Germany sent by the European Intercultural Forum e. V. in the local youth organisation "SIQA- Georgian Association for Educational Initiatives" in Rustavi, Georgia. [See the profile of Association SIQA.](#)

The project aims to empower young people from Germany and from Georgia. Objectives of the volunteering activities are as follow:

- To strengthen key competences of young people (volunteers and their local peers) especially civic, cross-social and intercultural competences
- To enhance active citizenship and social responsibility of young people from Germany and Georgia
- To inspire young people by giving them the opportunity to explore the role of civil society in fostering social inclusion, equality and peace
- To promote volunteering and active participation as a tool for personal and professional development

The two volunteers from Germany will organise diverse types of activities for and with local young people for example:

- Educational activities such as language clubs in German, English and/ or other languages and cultures, workshops, discussion clubs, movie screening's, on European values, intercultural dialogue, etc. - depending on the interest and skills of the volunteers;
- Leisure activities for local young people such as arts and crafts workshops, music club, sport activities, role games, theatre club, etc. – depending on the interest and skills of the volunteers
- Promotion of volunteering via photo exhibitions, open events in public space, presentations in schools, shooting and editing of short movies, etc.
- Blogging and writing articles on volunteering in Georgia
- Learning the local language, Georgian, and participating in activities of the local community

Thanks to the activities, the volunteers will gain competences relevant for their personal and professional development, among other self-confidence, working in a multicultural team, presentation

skills, leading workshops in foreign languages, planning and running activities, designing promotional materials, using social media, etc.

Conditions: the programme provides following:

- Accommodation (together with other volunteers in a shared furnished flat),
- Monthly food allowance based on local standards,
- Local transportation costs (home to office),
- International insurance,
- Language support in Georgian,
- Vaccination costs (if applicable),
- Pocket money: 55 EUR per month
- International travel costs home-project-home

The volunteers will work about 35 hours a week and are entitled to 2 days off per worked months and local national holidays.

Profile:

- Resident in Germany (of any citizenship) and age: 18-29 years old
- Highly motivated to volunteer in the youth sector
- Showing a great deal of flexibility and adaptability
- Motivated and enthusiastic to live for one year in another culture

We particularly encourage young people with no or few experiences but with high motivation and adaptability to apply!
